1. Acceptance

It is not necessary for any Client to have signed an acceptance of these terms and conditions for them to apply. If a Client accepts a quote, then the Client will be deemed to have satisfied themselves as to the terms applying and have accepted these terms and conditions in full.

2. Payment Terms

- 2.1. A 50% deposit of the total project fee is required before any work commences.
- 2.2. The remaining 50% will be payable upon completion of the project, prior to the final delivery or transfer of the website to the Client.

3. Cancellation Policy

- 3.1. If the value of the work completed exceeds the amount covered by the deposit, the Client will be invoiced for any additional time spent that has not been paid for by the deposit.
- 3.2. If the Designer has substantially completed the work (as reasonably determined by the Designer), the full balance may still be payable.

4. Scope of Work

- 4.1. The Designer will complete the work as agreed in the written proposal or project brief provided to the Client.
- 4.2. Any additional requests, features, or changes outside the original scope may incur extra charges, which will be quoted and agreed upon in writing before proceeding.

5. Client Responsibilities

5.1. The Client agrees to provide all necessary content, materials, and feedback to enable the Designer to complete the project as scheduled.

6. Project Delivery

6.1. Once the final balance is received, the completed website will be delivered, transferred, or made live.

7. Revisions

- 7.1. The Client is entitled to 3 rounds of revisions as part of the quoted fee.
- 7.2. Additional revisions or significant design changes beyond this may incur extra costs.

8. Termination by the Designer

8.1. The Designer reserves the right to terminate the project if the Client fails to meet obligations, including failure to pay or communicate, after reasonable notice.
8.2. In such cases, the Client will be responsible for payment of all completed work up to the date of termination.

9. Liability

- 9.1. The Designer will make every effort to deliver high-quality, functional work but is not responsible for:
 - Website downtime caused by hosting providers or third parties.
 - Issues arising from Client-supplied content.
 - Any consequential losses following delivery of the final product.
